<Theme Explanation>

The Humanities in the Age of AI Transformation: Exploring Paths to Coexistence

The overarching theme of the 8th World Humanities Forum is “The Humanities in the Age of AI Transformation”, with the general theme “Exploring Paths to Coexistence”. The humanities must respond to the changing times by reexamining fundamental questions about humanity and offering the best possible answers.

AI has become the new center of paradigm shifts in our time. The AI transformation is fundamentally reshaping both our society and individual lives. The humanities must respond from a new perspective to issues such as the nature of an increasingly complex world, the conditions necessary for human life, the qualities required to adapt to change, the direction of ethics and education in a changing era, human subjectivity and identity, cultural transformation, and the socio-economic upheavals brought about by changes in the labor market.

It is also a time when discourses on many issues facing humanity, such as coexistence between nature and civilization, between cultures, between generations, and between technology and humanity, must be further developed and made more concrete. Rather than merely reflecting on the past and present, we must now ask, from the perspective of the humanities, “What shall we do for tomorrow?”

Proposal Submission Guideline

1. Theme

<Main Theme> The Humanities in the Age of AI Transformation: Approximately 9 General Sessions

<General Theme> Exploring Paths to Coexistence: Approximately 9 General Sessions

2. Participants

- General Session Presenters: Approximately 36 domestic scholars, 36 international scholars

3. Key Dates (Changed)

- Proposal Submission: June 9 (Mon) - July 6 (Sun), 2025
- Notification of Selection Results: August 8 (Fri), 2025
- Final Paper Submission Deadline: September 30 (Tue), 2025

4. Manuscript Guidelines

- Proposal: Around 1,500 words in English or 2,500 characters in Korean
 - ※ To be submitted via the World Humanities Forum website (www.whf.kr)
- Final Paper: Around 4,000 words in English or 8,000 characters in Korean
 - ※ All abstracts and papers will be included in the Forum's digital proceedings
- The official languages for presentations: Korean or English
 - ※ AI interpretation will be provided for all sessions.

5. Conditions and Support

- All forum participants are required to stay on-site for the

full duration of the forum and attend sessions and networking events.

- Domestic scholars will receive an honorarium and full accommodation and meals for the duration of the forum.
- International scholars will be provided with round-trip travel expenses (or honorarium), full accommodation and meals, and a local tour.
